Homework Policy

September 2023

Introductory Statement:

This policy was formulated after consultation with the teachers, pupils, parents and Board of Management of Moneenroe National School.

- Homework to be based on reinforcement of day's work.
- Establish a routine, i.e., content of work.
- Children receive homework Monday to Thursday night (inclusive)
- No homework at weekends (unless one chooses to use it as a disciplinary measure).
- Children from 1st class up must have a homework journal.
- Homework to be signed nightly by parent/guardian.
- Time Homework: Children from 3rd to 6th class – time homework nightly
- Homework for children with specific learning needs is differentiated by the class teacher.
- Teacher may wish to specify a maximum time spent on homework for children with specific difficulties.
- Teachers to co-ordinate with resource/learning support teachers regarding homework given to their class.
- Homework for children with specific learning needs may be assigned by Learning Support Teacher.

“Homework OFF”

- No Homework on Friday.
- The children may receive ‘homework off’ in the lead up to the school holidays at the teachers’ discretion.
- One piece of written homework off on Monday for class group who win best line the previous week.
- No homework on the day before school tour.

Promotion of Policy:

Parents and staff will promote the Homework Policy throughout the school and at home. The Homework Policy will be on display in the Reception Hall. All teachers will be given a copy of our Homework Policy. Parents will be made aware of our Homework Policy at our Infant Introduction Day, Parent/Teacher meetings and through Parents Association Newsletter. As a whole school, children will be reminded about the importance of homework at the whole school Assembly.

This Policy shall be subject to annual review.
